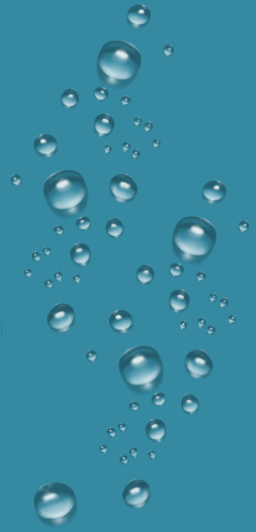

Course Overview

Duration: Part-time over five months

Delivery: In-person clinical training combined with online theory sessions

Assessment: Written examination, practical assessments and supervised case studies

Modules Covered

- Nutrition and Introduction to Functional Medicine

- Anatomy, Physiology, Pathophysiology and Pharmacology
- Equipment and Clinic Set-Up

- Practice Management, Business and Finance
- Gut Testing



RICTAT Colon Hydrotherapy Association Membership

Students receive three months of complimentary RICTAT membership from the date of qualification. After this period, the monthly membership fee will apply. RICTAT membership must be maintained for a minimum of 12 months.

Online Theory Sessions

Four live Zoom-based theory sessions provide a comprehensive academic and professional foundation, covering:

- The role of colon hydrotherapy within modern healthcare
- Historical and contemporary developments
- Client assessment and health questionnaires
- Indications, contraindications, red flags and referral pathways
- Infection control, COSHH, medications and lab testing
- Ethics, professional conduct and business foundations

Practical Clinical Training

Seven days (63 contact hours) of in-person clinical training, including:

- Client-led assessment and treatment planning
- Digital Rectal Examination (DRE) and abdominal assessment
- Treatment protocols and colon hydrotherapy techniques
- Documentation, reflective practice and clinical decision-making
- Equipment preparation, hygiene and infection control
- Treatment aftercare and follow-up planning

Clients are provided for the students and students can have colon hydrotherapy treatments themselves if they wish.



Assessment and Qualification

Students are assessed through a written examination, observed practical assessments and supervised case studies.

Resit opportunities are available should a student not meet the required standard, subject to a small administrative fee.

Student Support and Mentorship

Graduates receive ongoing support through:

- A dedicated professional online community
- Post-training mentorship
- Business set-up guidance
- Equipment and insurance support
- Continuing professional development opportunities



Conference and Continuing Professional Development (CPD)

All graduates are required to carry out 30 hours of ongoing professional development per year through a range of CPD opportunities.

An annual in-person conference offers a valuable platform for networking with peers, reflective practice and the sharing of clinical experience. The conference also features expert guest speakers from within the field, providing up-to-date insights, evidence-based knowledge and exposure to emerging practices that support both professional growth and high standards of client care.

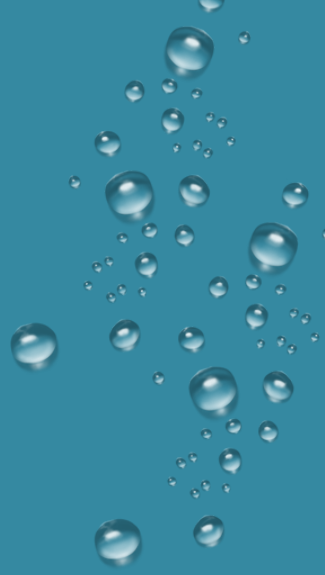
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Fees and Payment Options

Online Learning

Complete the Introduction to Functional Nutrition module

Attend four online theory sessions via Zoom, including Anatomy & Physiology content, Colonic Hydrotherapy theory, the core principles of gut health, gut testing, accreditation, business & marketing, set up and equipment



Practical Training

Undertake seven days of in-person, hands-on practical training

Learn equipment setup, treatment protocols, hygiene standards, client care, consultation and assessment skills and supervised practical techniques



Final Assessment

Complete your final exam and practical assessment to achieve certification as a RICTAT Colonic Hydrotherapist

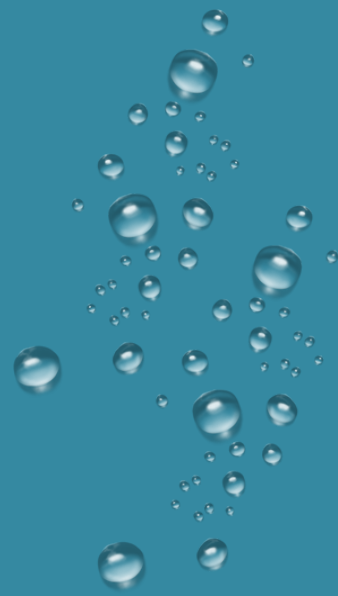
